

- Process in development of medicines/vaccines/delivery devices
- Runs in phases 1-4
- Regulatory approval process: FDA and safety standards.
- Demonstrating safety and effectiveness through evidence.
- Rigorous design and monitoring of clinical trials.
- Participant safety top priority.

# FLAIR – Asthma Study

- Asthma is when airways become swollen (inflamed) and sometimes narrowed
- This effects movement of air (contained oxygen) in and out of the lungs
- Causes wheezing/ chest tightness
- Asthma is one of the most common diseases in the world
- Effects all ages
- Causes of worsening symptoms include:
  - Pollen, viral infections, cold air, chemical toxins



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# FLAIR Asthma study – who can participate

- Aim of study is to investigate an investigational drug which is a combination of 2 commercially available drugs used to treat asthma in one inhaler.
- Who can participate:
- People over 16 years of age
- Diagnosed with asthma for at least a year
- Had 1 or more asthma attacks /exacerbations of asthma in the last 12 months that have been treated with steroids for 3 days or have been hospitalised for >24 hours with asthma




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# CORAL REEF – High Cholesterol Study

- High cholesterol levels a risk factor for cardiovascular events
    - Heart attack
    - Stroke
  - These events can lead to serious illness or death
  - Testing a potential new drug called Enlicitide
  - To reduce risk of cardiovascular events
  - Enlicitide is a PK-9 inhibitor
  - PK9 is a protein that breaks down your LDL receptors
  - LDL receptors normally carriers LDL from your blood to your liver to get rid of
- Reduces LDL cholesterol (“bad cholesterol”)
  - Sponsored by Merck Sharp & Dohme (MSD)
  - 14 550 participants world wide
  - 2 groups 1:1 active treatment vs placebo
  - Current approved PK-9 inhibitor in other countries an injection – trial medication a tablet



# CORAL REEF High Cholesterol Study - who can participate

- Aged 18 years and older
  - Currently on a Statin
  - History of Heart Attack or Stroke
- Or
- Risk factors for major cardiovascular event
    - Cardiovascular disease
    - History of CABG / Stents
    - High Blood Pressure
    - Diabetes Type 2
    - Current smoker
    - Aged older than 70



# Eczema (Atopic Dermatitis)

- Eczema an inflammatory skin disease
- Disrupts protective barrier function of the skin
- Characterised by itchiness, dryness and irritable skin
- Can impact on quality of life
- Investigating an anti-inflammatory treatment for moderate to severe Eczema
- Aged 18 years and older.
- Diagnosed with moderate to severe Eczema for more than 6 months
- Stable health


